Introduction

Some 2024 Tacoma vehicles equipped with a Blind Spot Monitor (BSM) may exhibit a condition where the Trailer Driving Assist Active message is displayed without a trailer connected. The BSM software has been updated. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.


Repair Procedure

1. Confirm the condition exists.

Is the Trailer Driving Assist Active message displayed without a trailer connected, as shown in Figure 1?

- **YES** Continue to step 2.
- **NO** This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.

2. Use GTS+ to confirm the BSM sensor calibrations.

Are the calibration IDs for the BSM sensors shown as 8816FAK02201 and 8816FAK02202?

- **YES** Continue to step 3
- **NO** This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.

Repair Procedure (continued)

3. Flash reprogram both BSM sensors.

NOTE

- The battery diagnostic tool MUST be used in Power Supply Mode to maintain battery voltage at 13.5V while flash reprogramming the vehicle.
- For details on how to use the battery diagnostic tool, refer to the <u>DCA-8000 Instruction Manual</u> located at *TIS Diagnostics Tools & Equipment Battery Diagnostics*.

Follow the procedures outlined in <u>T-SB-0107-20</u>, *GTS+ ECU Flash Reprogramming With Security Signature*, and flash reprogram BOTH BSM sensors with the NEW calibration file update.

- 4. Using GTS+, perform a Health Check and clear ANY stored DTCs.
- 5. Confirm the condition is no longer present.

The Trailer Driving Assist Active message will either:

No longer be displayed.

OR

 Need to be cleared by selecting YES on the "No Trailer Detected" pop up message after moving forward at a speed greater than 6 mph (10 km/h) for at least 10 seconds.
